A FAMILY HOME VISITING PROGRAM

What We Offer Your Family

Through early intervention and in-home coaching and education, we increase parenting skills and family stability to avoid entry into the child welfare system. We support parents with at least one child age 10 or younger to identify risk factors to child and family well-being. We connect parents to community resources for family health, basic needs (such as housing) or access to financial assistance.

WHO WE SERVE

Families who live in Hennepin County.

Parents who are pregnant or have at least one child under age 10 living at home.

Families that need help with issues that make it hard to parent, such as: money problems, addiction, domestic violence, homelessness, abuse, neglect or behavioral health concerns.

OUR FAMILY SERVICES

Schedule Home Visits with families to meet them where they are.

We help to identify risk factors that are impacting a family's overall behavior or well-being.

We help families access support for medical needs, basic needs and financial assistance.

We provide short-term assistance to families for up to six months.

We may make referrals to other programs at The Family Partnership.

HOW TO ENROLL

Enrollment is by referrals from community agencies, school staff or clients who are looking for help addressing concerns at home.
