Eligibility:

- Pregnant women
- New parents/caregivers with children within 3 months of birth
- Families with children under 24 months old with active child protection cases (referred by a county caseworker).

Cost:

- Services are covered by most insurances
- Grant funding is available for those without insurance and live in Hennepin County.
