PRIDE – Promoting Recovery, Independence, Dignity, and Equality (anti-sex trafficking program)

Time of day and schedule of the position	Various times throughout the day, ranging from early morning to late at night
Duration of the position	Ongoing
Location of the position	Surrounding Twin Cities Area, but in the vicinity of both of The Family Partnership's locations

A background check is needed for this volunteer position.

References are not needed for this volunteer position.

The goal of this activity is to serve as an approachable individual who can help staff to put on additional outreach opportunities. The volunteer will be accompanying staff when they go out into the community to connect with individuals who are affected by the human trafficking industry or affected by sexual exploitation.

Volunteers will be responsible for:

- Attending outreach events with a staff member
- Interacting with community members and being advocates for The Family Partnership's PRIDE Program
- Handing out hygiene kits and other resources, as necessary
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements and qualifications: Volunteers must adhere to strict boundary guidelines be comfortable accompanying a staff member in the community to do outreach with vulnerable populations. Volunteers who enjoy making conversation and interacting with people from various backgrounds are encouraged to apply. People who speak multiple languages or who have skills that they'd like to share are desired, as are individuals who succeed at creating a non-threatening atmosphere and are trained in de-escalation techniques. People with knowledge of Narcan use and first aid are encouraged to apply.
