

How to Make Flubber

Materials:

- ³⁄₄ cup cold water
- 1 cup Elmer's glue (or any white school glue)
- Liquid food coloring
- ½ cup hot water
- 1 teaspoon borax

Directions:

- In bowl 1, mix together the cold water, glue, and food coloring. Set aside.
- In bowl 2, mix together the hot water and borax, until the borax is completely dissolved.
- Slowly add glue mixture to borax mixture. Mix well. Pour off excess water.
- Place in airtight storage container.

Sample Label:

Flubber (For playing, Not eating)

Ingredients include: 3/4 cup cold water, 1 cup Elmer's glue (or any white school glue), Liquid food coloring, 1/2 cup hot water, and 1 teaspoon borax.
