Strategies for driving change

RESEARCH-BASED STRATEGIES

TFP's groundbreaking **"Executive Functioning Across Generations"** is the first 2Gen curriculum designed to boost executive functioning skills for preschool children and their parents. New partnerships with the Harvard Center on the Developing Child – Frontiers of Innovation and the Children's Home Society of America will expand test sites nationally for further refinement of the curriculum.

TFP expanded use of evidence-based coaching by offering **InterGen, a fully 2Gen version of Mobility Mentoring®**. TFP is the only program in Minnesota, and one of only 5 organizations in the country, using InterGen to help adults and their children assess their situation, set their own goals, and work towards greater economic success.

NATIONAL AFFILIATIONS

Three TFP members presented at Aspen Institute's 2019 Aspen ThinkXChange:

Advancing Family Prosperity in Colorado, sharing approaches to promote family strengths and prosperity.

Molly Greenman continued to serve as the board chair of The Alliance for Strong Families and Communities, a national strategic action network of hundreds of community-based organizations striving to achieve a healthy and equitable society.

TFP is an active member of Change in Mind, an international brain science collaboration of the Alliance and the Palix Foundation of Alberta, Canada.

Early Education & Developmental Therapies

*Our therapeutic preschools meet children where they are.
We provide immediate therapeutic interventions and curriculums
on math, scientific-inquiry, reading and executive functioning.*

SERVICES INCLUDE

- **Two Multicultural Therapeutic Preschools**

Our North Minneapolis preschool is an anchor partner of Northside Achievement Zone (NAZ)

Our Four Directions Family Center partners with Wicoie Nandagikendan on Dakota and Ojibwe language immersion classes

- **Developmental Screenings and Therapies**

(occupational, speech, music and play)

- **Drop-in Day Care Centers**

(at Hennepin and Ramsey County)

We served **223 children** in early education and therapy services at our preschools.

Additionally, we served **14,052 children** from **5,126 households** at our Drop-in Day Care Centers in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties.

PARTICIPANT OUTCOMES

87% *of children graduated from preschool ready for kindergarten*

80% *of preschool graduates tested at or above the national median for executive functioning, a predictor of success in school and life (using the Minnesota Executive Functioning Scale)*

96% *of families with children enrolled in our preschools demonstrated increased knowledge and skills in child development and parenting*

93% *of families of preschoolers promoted language development at home*

Our experienced, multi-lingual and culturally diverse teaching staff, therapists and family workers setup kids for success.

Rated as Strong Beginnings Centers by Hennepin County and the Minnesota Department of Human Services.





Parent Development & Engagement

We support parents and caregivers to build family well-being and overcome challenges.

SERVICES INCLUDE

- **Build family skills** to overcome challenges through groups and home visits
- Intensive prenatal and infant programs for families
- **Connections to community resources** for family health, basic needs or access to financial assistance
- **Tracking children's growth and development**
- Keeping families together or reuniting them
- Mobility Mentoring®/InterGen partners with parents/caregivers and their children to **set and achieve economic mobility goals**

We served **914** parents/caregivers and children from **282** households.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES

100% *of babies with prenatal risk factors were born healthy*

93% *of parents currently involved with Child Protection reduced their risk factors for child maltreatment*

71% *of parents at-risk for Child Protection involvement reduced their risk factors for child maltreatment and stressors due to unmet basic needs*

For children to thrive, their caregivers must also thrive. And for parents to prosper, their children must prosper.



Healthy Families America® is a 25+ year evidence-based 2Gen program.



Mental Health Services

Our counselors help meet the unique needs of children, teens and adults dealing with adversity and trauma.

SERVICES INCLUDE

Diagnostic assessments and evidence-based therapies for low-income children, youth and adults:

- Individual or group therapies
- Play therapies
- In-home therapies
- School-linked or in-school services

We served **1,920** low-income youth and adults.

PARTICIPANT OUTCOMES

96% *of criminal justice-involved youth served through intensive in-home counseling avoided school expulsions and out-of-home placement*

83% *of youth reported stronger family relationships*

88% *of young children in counseling programs maintained/improved their scores on a standardized measure of therapeutic need*

OUR INTERNSHIPS

We provide paid internships to graduate students of color and the LGBTQ+ community to increase diversity in clinical social work.

We recruit students for **Diversity Social Work Advancement Program (DSWAP)** internships from: Augsburg University, St. Catherine University, University of Minnesota and University of St. Thomas.



Support & Advocacy for Sex Trafficking Survivors

For 42 years, our PRIDE (Promoting Recovery, Independence, Dignity, and Equality) program has supported survivors of sexual exploitation with comprehensive services.

NEW INITIATIVES

- **Survivor Leadership Group** – led by three trafficking survivors, this group gives a voice to the needs of longer-term survivors.
- **Expungement Clinic** – hosted in partnership with Standpoint and the Volunteer Lawyers network. The clinic helps put survivors on the pathway to remove barriers to employment, housing or higher education due to their records.
- **LGBTQ+/Male survivors** – helped conduct research with University of Minnesota Urban Research Outreach Center on the unmet needs of these survivor communities.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES

80% of participants maintained/improved scores towards exiting sexual exploitation and rebuilding their lives. Examples include:

- *Better income, transportation and childcare access*
- *Reduced criminal justice system involvement*
- *Overall improved lifestyle and safety*

80% of participants maintained or improved scores on a tool measuring individual goal achievement in five essential areas:

- *Family stability*
- *Well-being*
- *Education and training*
- *Financial management*
- *Employment and career management*

WE SERVED

637 victims/survivors of all ages.

WE TRAINED

785 people to recognize sex trafficking and how to respond.

We offer support groups and case management to survivors so, when they are ready, it is easier for them to exit sexual exploitation.
