Suggested Language for Making a Bequest to The Family Partnership

You may include a bequest to support The Family Partnership when preparing your will or by adding a codicil to your present will. Bequests may be of cash, securities, real estate or other property. Bequests of all sizes are welcome, whether they are outright, contingent or residual.

Your request should be directed to **The Family Partnership**. The following language may be useful to your attorney:

Specific Bequest – “I give The Family Partnership Minneapolis, MN, the sum of \$_____ to be used for the general support of The Family Partnership.”

Residual Bequest – “I give The Family Partnership Minneapolis, MN, _____ percent of the residue of my estate to be used for the general support of The Family Partnership.”

Contingent Bequest – “In the event that _____ predeceases me, I give The Family Partnership Minneapolis, MN, the sum of \$_____ (or, alternatively, _____ percent of the residue of my estate) to be used for the general support of The Family Partnership.”
