The goal of this activity is to serve as an in-person event support for drop-in Community Health Fairs run by our PRIDE program. The volunteer(s) will greet guests to the Community Health Fair, assist them with getting to the correct room, and help monitor items guests store while they attend the health fair.

Volunteers will be responsible for:

- Supporting setup and cleanup of the Fair
- Greeting guests and directing them to the Community Health Fair
- Assisting with any initial questions guests may have and connecting them with the proper point
 of contact
- Monitoring storage area for client items

Requirements and qualifications: Volunteers must adhere to strict boundary guidelines. Volunteers who enjoy making conversation and interacting with people from various backgrounds are encouraged to apply. People who speak multiple languages or who have skills that they'd like to share are desired, as are individuals who succeed at creating a non-threatening atmosphere and are trained in de-escalation techniques. People with knowledge of Narcan use and first aid are encouraged to apply.
