# Thanks for supporting whole-family healing

In 2023, your generous support helped clear the path to success for children and families from 1,178 households.

- 46% were infants to 18 years old
- 88% were living in low-income households
- 86% were Black, Indigenous, and people of color
- 60% were girls and women
- 3% were transgender and gender non-conforming





## **IMPACT STORY**

All three of Taya and Courtney's children attended The Family Partnership's therapeutic preschool in North Minneapolis—including their youngest, five-year-old Zayvior.

Our developmental therapists worked with Zayvior onsite at the preschool to build speech, behavior, and fine motor skills. By the time Zayvior graduated from our preschool program, he tested kindergarten-ready, as did his entire graduating class!

Zayvior and his classmates' achievements are especially significant, because they live in a community where just 50% of children test kindergarten-ready. Research shows that kindergarten readiness leads to higher rates of academic success, graduation, workforce participation and earning potential across a lifetime. Studies also show these benefits continue into the next generation as children grow up and become parents themselves.

### **Early Childhood Education and Care**

- 100% of children graduated kindergarten-ready
- 100% of parents increased knowledge of child development
- 100% of children received developmental screenings



### **Mental Health Therapies**

- **92**% of criminal-justice involved youth avoided out-of-home placement
- 89% of youth in outpatient therapy reported stronger relationships
- 86% of children in developmental therapies reached their treatment goals



# **Family Home Visiting**

- 85% of parents improved daily living skills including financial and home management
- 85% of parents with open CPS cases increased parenting skills
- 100% of families identified by CPS as at-risk had no CPS cases opened



### **Anti-Sex Trafficking**

- 97% of PRIDE participants maintained or improved access to healthcare
- 93% of PRIDE participants decreased involvement in the commercial sex industry



# **Mobility Mentoring®**

- 86% of participants maintained or improved housing status
- 89% of participants maintained or improved employment status and earnings
